PART – A

The plan of action chalked out by the IQAC in the beginning of the year towards quality enhancement and the successful accomplishment by the end of the year :

I. To ensure academic excellence and enhance the qualitative performance, the institution has proposed to implement the following programmes during the academic year 2009-2010.

1. Making optimum use of the autonomous status enrolling 3165 at the UG level and 557 students in the post-graduate courses, 101 scholars in M.Phil, 26 research scholars in Ph.D. programmes, the college offers qualitative & inclusive education for the academic upliftment of women students.

2. Designing courses based on the societal and environmental requirements, a need based curriculum with choice based credit system under cafeteria system has been framed to make the students more employable in the prevailing hi-tech knowledge community.

3. Motivating and supporting the faculty members to meet the challenges and growing demands of Higher Education by:

- Enriching and enhancing research by promoting creativity and innovation.
- Participating and presenting papers in National / International Seminars/ Conferences / Workshops..
- Augmenting research activities by publishing works in reputed National / International journals / Magazines / edited books and single authored books.
- Providing research funds to organize National / International Seminars/ Conferences on current topics of academic and social relevance keeping abreast with the global trends.

- Fostering global competitiveness by promoting the use of technology and creating an atmosphere towards quest for excellence.

II. To achieve academic excellence and enhance institutional quality, the following programmes have been successfully implemented during the academic year 2009-2010.

- (a) To envisage the vision statement of the institution, various programmes have been designed to impart value based quality education to empower women and transform them into excellent architects in nation building.
- (b) In order to cater to the needs of the aspiring students and keep abreast of the emerging trends in Higher Education, skill based / choice based electives under cafeteria system following TANSCH norms have been introduced. Students are motivated to opt for self-learning papers in the UG & PG stream. M.Phil (FT/PT) has been introduced in Mathematics and Physics and Ph.D (FT/PT) in Computer Science. UGC sponsored Diploma Course in Tourism and Hospitality Management and PG Diploma in Insurance Management has been introduced.
- (c) The institution encourages faculty participation in Research by motivating the faculty members to pursue research on part-time basis. Faculty members are encouraged to present papers in National Seminars and Conferences by making use of UGC, PTAC grants and also motivated to participate in International Conferences. The faculty members have benefited by the unstinted support offered by the institution and have displayed their expertise and research acumen in an outstanding manner. A spurt of research activities have been recorded in several disciplines.

d. Community Development Programmes have been carried out on a regular and continuous basis for the upliftment of the downtrodden and underprivileged sections of the society. As many as 50 programmes were executed by service units such as NSS, YRC, RRC, Enviro-Club, Bio-health Club, Women Cell, EDP Cell, 'Consumer Club', 'Velichangal' and 'Sigarangal' Forums.

e. Training Programmes for the teaching & non-teaching staff and the students.

Yoga and Meditation

Students of the I year UG classes were introduced to a week-long Yoga & Meditation classes to enable them to develop concentration and self-confidence. They were exposed to various yoga practices to distress the mind and develop physical fitness and mental alertness.

Faculty Development Programmes

i. A special programme on Quality Enhancement was organized by the IQAC with Dr.Pankaj Mittal, Vice-chancellor Bhagat Phool Singh Mahila Vishwa Vidhayalaya as the resource person. The need for identifying and boistering core-competency to sustain and enhance quality performance by being strategic was stressed.

ii. A Faculty Development Programme on "Total Quality Management in Teaching" was organized with Dr.B.Vanitha, Associate Prof. of Economics, Bharathiar University, Coimbatore who articulated on the elements, indicators and dimensions of TQM.

iii. A Workshop on “Orientation and Retraining of Teachers was organized by IQAC – Dr. Joseph Durairaj, Prof. of English, Gandhigram Rural University highlighted the significance of research publications and Dr. Jayalakshmi, Head, Dept. of English Language Studies, Madurai Kamaraj University focused on Syllabus Design & Material Production by advocating a learner – centric approach in framing the syllabus.

Entrepreneurship training

Skill-based activities were organized by the Entrepreneurship Development Programme Cell to develop application skills & life skills. Students exhibited their creativity and innate capability through multifarious activities.

Students of the department of Costume Design and Fashion exhibited their products like toys, glass paintings, house-hold items, accessories and apparel in a 2 day exhibition–cum-sale which showcased their talents and skill. A tie-up with Abirami Beauty Parlour has been a launching pad for students to learn the art of make-over and grooming and also offer client service for students and faculty of the institution.

In the mission of weeding out the marketing problems and to empower underprivileged rural women who have organized into SHGS, a five-day exhibition-cum-sale of SHG’s products in unison with the Mahalir Thittam was organized by the PG & Research Department of Commerce.

To conclude on a positive note the Institution has been providing a unique platform for the students, faculty and administrative staff to unleash their potential and re-invent themselves.

NSS:

- NSS plays a vital role in academic expansion. NSS units of our college under the guidance of Ms.Shahida Shireen & Ms.S.Jayalakshmi of the Dept. of Physics, work with the objective of developing the personality of students through community services.

- Multifaceted activities provides a variety of learning experience, develops a sense of participation, service and achievement among the volunteers, making the volunteers more accountable to the society and moulding them into future leaders.
- The regular activities of NSS started with the orientation programme to the newly enrolled volunteers. Activities like tree plantation, campus cleaning and blood group identification were carried out. Seminars and Workshops were organized on Cancer Awareness, Organ Donation, Role of NSS in Higher Education and Road Safety Measures.
- NSS Volunteers observed the World Population Day, International antidrugs Day, Energy Day, and Elders Day, by way of conducting competitions, debates, displaying placards, visit to the Old Age Home and Home for the Boys under Social Defence Departments.

36. Activities of the Career Guidance and Counseling Unit:

The Career Guidance Cell plays a pivotal role in enhancing the employability of the graduates by organizing on-campus and off-campus training programmes, thereby motivating them to capitalize on the immense

job opportunities. The training, inclusive of life-skills and placement-oriented programmes is imparted by eminent persons from diverse areas of specialization, enabling the ready absorption of the graduates by National and Multi-national companies.

- The Cell conducted a “Career Counseling” for the final year UG and PG students with Prof.S.Palaniswami and Mr. Ram Duraisamy as resource persons on 20th July, 2009.
- The Cell conducted an awareness programme on “Advanced Teaching Methodology” in association with Everonn Systems India Limited, Chennai, on 24th July, 2009.
- A motivating programme on “Leadership Skills” was organised on 22nd September, 2009 with Mr.Shanmuga Sundaram, Rotary Club, Erode, as the trainer.
- To ignite the interest to appear for Civil Service Examinations, the Cell, in association with Brilliant IAS Academy, Chennai conducted a mock test on 22nd January, 2010.
- On 25th January, 2010, a Faculty Development Programme was conducted with Mrs.B.Brindha, Educational Advisor, United States-India Educational Foundation, as the resource person. She elaborated on the scholarships and grants available to the faculty members and the meritorious students to study in United States.
- The Cell organised a “Video Conference” with Prof. Anand and Mr. Raghunathan of Everonn Systems, on 4th February, 2010. They discussed the future scope in ICT enabled services.

37. Placement Services:

The Placement Cell of the Institution, established in 1997, has been functioning effectively in imparting courage and self-confidence in the students by finding them jobs through various on and off-campus interviews.

The final year UG and PG students both Regular and Self-financed, actively participated in various on and off-campus interviews conducted by companies like Accenture, Tech Mahindra, IBM, Sutherland, Royal Bank of Scotland and Spectrum Infotech.

The students participated in the on-campus interviews conducted by KGISL, Coimbatore, SHARP Infotech, Coimbatore, B2K Medical Transcription Training Academy, Erode, HDFC Life Insurance, Coimbatore, Seyyone Solutions, Coimbatore, and the Indian Public School, Erode.
