  - Augmenting research activities by publishing works in reputed National / International journals / Magazines / edited books and single authored books.

- Providing research funds to organize National / International Seminars/ Conferences on current topics of academic and social relevance keeping abreast with the global trends.
- Fostering global competitiveness by promoting the use of technology and creating an atmosphere towards quest for excellence.

# II. To achieve academic excellence and enhance institutional quality, the following programmes have been successfully implemented during the academic year 2010-2011.

- (a) To envisage the vision statement of the institution, various programmes have been designed to impart value based quality education to empower women and transform them into excellent architects in nation building.
- (b) In order to cater to the needs of the aspiring students and keep abreast of the emerging trends in Higher Education, skill based / choice-based electives under cafeteria system following TANSCHE norms have been introduced. Students are motivated to opt for self-learning papers in the UG & PG stream and earn extra credits. M.Sc Computer Science has been introduced this year.
- (c) The institution encourages faculty participation in Research by motivating the faculty members to pursue research on part-time basis. Faculty members are encouraged to present papers in International, National Seminars and Conferences by making use of UGC, PTAC grants and also motivated to participate in International Conferences abroad. The faculty members have benefited by the unstinted support offered by the institution and have displayed their expertise and research acumen in an outstanding manner. A spurt of research activities have been recorded in several disciplines.

- 43 Seminars / Conferences / Workshops were organized by various departments.
- 1 Faculty member attended the UGC Orientation Course conducted by Bharathiar University, Coimbatore.
- 6 Faculty members attended UGC Refresher Course conducted by Bharathiar University.
- 13 Ph.D. Scholars were produced.
- 64 M.Phil Scholars were produced by various Departments.
- d. Community Development Programmes have been carried out on a regular and continuous basis for the upliftment of the downtrodden and underpriviledged sections of the society. As many as 50 programmes were executed by service units such as NSS, YRC, RRC, Enviro-Club, Bio-health Club, Women Cell, EDP Cell, 'Consumer Club', 'Velichangal' and 'Sigarangal' Forums.

# e. Training Programmes for the teaching & non-teaching staff and the students.

#### Yoga and Meditation

Students of the I year UG classes were introduced to a week-long Yoga & Meditation classes to enable them to develop concentration and self-confidence. They were exposed to various yoga practices to destress the mind and develop physical fitness and mental alertness.

#### **Faculty Development Programmes**

A Faculty Development Program 'Resources for Researchers' was organized by the IQAC in co-ordination with the Research Committee on 04.09.2010. Professor M.A.Velusami, Kongu Engineering College, Perundurai and Ms.R.Samyuktha, Librarian, Central University, Pondicherry, were the Resource Persons.

The IQAC and the Counselling Cell jointly organized a Two-Day Faculty Development Workshop on "Teaching Effectiveness Drives – A Personality Focus", with Dr. P. Suriarajan, Ph.D., Psychologist, educator and counselor from PSAR Consultancy, Madurai, as Resource person.

In connection with Faculty Development Program, a UGC sponsored Workshop on 'Material Production' was conducted from 16.11.2010 to 18.11.2010 with Prof.N.Krishnaswamy, Former Professor, CIEFL, Hyderabad and Mrs.Lalitha Krishnaswamy, mentor, author and educational consultant, as resource persons.

A UGC sponsored one-day Program on 'Competency Building' for faculty members has been organized jointly by the PG & Research Departments of Commerce and History on 22.03.2011. Dr.S.Selvam, Director, Centre for University – Industry Collaboration, Anna University, Chennai, handled the two technical sessions with a focus on value added teaching to make teaching and learning more effective.

Department of Mathematics organized a UGC sponsored program on 'Competence Building for Teachers' on 24.01.2011. Dr.V.Laxmana Gomathi Nayagam, Professor of Mathematics, NIT, Trichy delivered a special lecture on "Enrich Yourself" which helped the teachers to meet the requirement of the era.

#### **Entrepreneurship training**

Skill-based activities were organized by the Entrepreneurship Development Programme Cell to develop application skills and life skills. Students exhibited their creativity and innate capability through multifarious activities.

Students of the department of Costume Design and Fashion exhibited their self-designed articles like toys, glass paintings, house-hold items, fashion accessories and garments in a 'Fashion Dallals' – a two day exhibition–cumsale which showcased their talents and skill.

One-day workshop about "Computer Aided Designing" on 21.08.2010 motivated the students in free hand fashion designing and accessories making and this knowledge helped the students to improve their designing capability.

A two-day workshop was conducted on "Fabric Painting Techniques", to enhance the students designing skills.

A two-day workshop on "Various Painting Techniques" educated the students to use their creativity to make innovative products using ceramic, sand and glass materials.

In the mission of weeding out the marketing problems and to empower underpriviledged rural women who have organized into SHG's, exhibition-cum-sale of SHG's products in unison with the Mahalir Thittam was organized by the PG & Research Department of Commerce.
