Mercy Ramya IAS, Assistant Collector (U/T), Erode District, who has graciously consented to be with us here today for the 47<sup>th</sup> Annual Day celebrations, to deliver the college day address and to distribute prizes to the students who have excelled in their academics. I extend a warm welcome to the dignitaries on the dais, faculty members, non-teaching staff, parents, students and all other invitees. Vellalar College for Women is the fruit of monumental efforts of a few visionaries of the Kongu Vellalar Community who nurtured and cradled this Institution with the grand vision of social and economic empowerment of rural women.

Before presenting a brief account of the activities and accomplishments during 2015 – 2016, let me place on record my respectful homage to the towering personalities who were behind the genesis and growth of this institution. I also record my deep sense of gratitude to the former members of the Vellalar Educational Trust and the former Principals of this Institution.

With the blessings of the God Almighty and with a deep sense of pride and pleasure, I now present the year long initiatives and attainments for the academic year 2016-17 to this august gathering.

## **Current Strength of the College**

The Academic year commenced on 16.06.2016, with **1495** students in the Under-Graduate and **235** students in the Post-Graduate programmes of the aided courses. **89** teaching staff and **21** non-teaching staff are serving in the Aided wing. A strength of **3231** students in the Under Graduate and **649** students in the Post Graduate programmes, **166** teaching staff and **100** non-teaching staff are in the Self-financing wing. **90** scholars have registered for M.Phil. and **62** scholars for Ph.D. programmes during the current year.

The activities of the academic year 2016-17 were meticulously planned and excellently executed by our teaching fraternity to effectively transform the students into respectable and responsible citizens of our country.

# **Courses offered**

The College offers **20** UG programmes and **12** PG programmes, **8** UGC sponsored Career-Oriented Add-on Courses, **3** Bharathiar University approved Certificate Courses, **11**other Certificate Programmes and **10** Research Programmes.

The Curriculum has been designed and worked out in accordance with the changing needs of the society, encompassing skill acquisition across the disciplines, creating more opportunities for global education with focus on career expectations.

There are **66** Rank Holders in UG programmes and **23** Rank Holders in PG programmes in the 2016-17 passed out batch.

#### **Grants Received**

Grants received from the University Grants Commission during this academic year under XII plan amounted to Rs. 85, 02,518.

Seven science departments are financially supported by the **Department of Science and Technology** under **FIST programme** (Fund for Improvement of Science and Technology Infrastructure) Scheme. The grant of **Rs.69.50 lakhs** was spent during this year for strengthening infrastructure of the identified departments for teaching, research and networking & computational facilities.

Dr. P. Indumathy, Associate Professor and Head, Dept. of Foods and Nutrition, has been selected as the Principal investigator (for the Erode site) of the **Indian Council of Medical Research** Task Force Multisite study on "Descriptive Epidemiology of Childhood Injuries in India" with an estimated budget of **Rs.23.9 lakhs** for a period of two and a half years.

## **Scholarships**

Government Scholarships (SC, BC and MBC) and other Scholarships from various Trusts to the tune of **Rs. 54**, **99**,**479** were offered to the students during the year 2016-17. As in the past under Bharathiar University Free Education Scheme **five** students were admitted in I year UG Programme.

S.Gowri, Ph.D. Scholar in Commerce was selected for Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR) Doctoral Fellowship (2015 -2017) and has received the fellowship amount of **Rs.2.07,000**/- for this academic year.

S.M.Dhivya, Ph.D Scholar of Botany has received the scholarship of **Rs. 72,000**/- from the Director of Collegiate Education.

Mrs.H.R.Sumathi, Assistant Professor of History received a grant of **Rs.36,000**/- from Indian Council of Historical Research (ICHR) for persuing Ph.D in History.

# **College Union Activities**

To trigger National integration and Communal harmony, various competitions on this, theme was conducted and winners were awarded with prizes. In connection with this the students visited the residences of freedom fighters, performed skit on "Jallian Wala Bagh Massacre", sang choir on patriotism and portrayed Dandi march. A candle light march was organized from college campus to Sengodampalayam. Dr.V.Jeevanandam, Nalanda Hospital & Founder President, Erode Trust Hospital, Erode hoisted the National Flag and gave Independence Day address on 15<sup>th</sup> August.

#### **Academic Activities**

A welcome party was arranged for the fresher's on 16<sup>th</sup> June 2016.

Bridge courses were conducted by all the departments to acclimatize the students from school to a new academic environment.

To promote Global Health, Harmony and Peace, **International Day of Yoga** was observed on 21<sup>st</sup> June 2016. To enhance personal power and to rejuvenate mind, body and soul the students attended a **four** day yoga programme given by *Manavalakalai Mandram*, Erode.

To discuss students progress and find solutions to academic and behavioral problems, Parent Teachers meeting were convened periodically.

Periodical counseling classes offer a space for mentors to discuss and solve the problems of their wards and remove barriers in academic achievements.

Remedial classes were conducted for the slow learners.

Civil service examination coaching was given to the interested students of final year UG and PG by Meridian Academy, Erode.

To prepare the graduates of English Literature to take up **UGC NET/ SET** examinations an Intensive Coaching was organized for two days.

Mr.T.Stephan and Ms.D.Mercy Lydia faculty of Library and Information Science on behalf of Society for Advancement of Library and Information Sciences (SALIS) took initiatives to set up reading booths into AC waiting halls of Erode Railway Junction with funding from *Olirum Erodu* which is the first of its kind in the whole of Indian Railways.

A three day exhibition cum sale **College Bazaar** was organized by PG and Research Department of Commerce in union with *Mahalir Thittam* of Tamil Nadu Corporation for Development of Women. **Corporate Mall** was organized by the PG and Research Department of Corporate Secretaryship to inculcate the retailing techniques among their students. **Trade Temptations**, an exhibition cum sale was organized by the Department of Business Administration with CA. The department of Costume Design & Fashion organized **Fashion Dalal** with the motive of promoting entrepreneurial skills of the learners.

An inter-collegiate meet - **CYBER EXPO 2016** was organized by the Department of Computer Science, Computer Applications and Computer Technology. An inter-collegiate Oratorical Competition sponsored by Chinnasamy Arakatalai was organized by the Department of Tamil. Two Intra-collegiate meets were organized by the Department of Biochemistry and Computer Applications. These programmes offered a platform for the students to interact, learn, exhibit and compete in the events of academic and general interests.

Our college is recognized as *Nodal Resource Centre* by Spoken Tutorial-IIT Mumbai for Erode region. The mission is to nurture and spread awareness about FOSS and Spoken Tutorial among colleges in Erode and neighbouring districts.

With Mr. Ramesh, HR Trainer, Jc International, Karur as the resource person, sessions were organized for the students to nurture the skills of fast reading and to imbibe certain memory techniques.

The college has inked Memorandum of Understanding with **Infosys BPO Limited** to impart global competency skills to learners.

Placement Cell conducted training programmes on *Aptitude* and *Soft skills* to improvise the skills of the students. **159** students were placed in reputed companies like Calibrant Technologies, Infosys IT, Infosys BPO, First American PVT Ltd, Accenta Training Solution, Amazon, IDBI Federal Life Insurance, Vee Technologies, AEE.BEE Academy etc.,

During this academic year 21 guest lectures, 15 special meetings, 12 workshops and 11 outreach programmes all funded by UGC were conducted by the aided departments. Unaided stream of the college organized 23 workshops, 30 guest lectures and 15 outreach programmes. An International Seminar funded by UGC was organized jointly by the department of Chemistry and

Zoology. **Two** national and **one** state level seminars, **two** national and **one** state level symposia funded by UGC were organized by the aided departments.

An Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR) funded International Conference was organized by the department of Commerce with CA. The selected papers of the conference were published in the Journal of Management and Science. In addition to this, **two** state level seminars, **one** national level conference and **one** national level symposium were organized by the unaided departments.

Under STAR College scheme, a DBT funded national symposium on *Computational Approaches in Biological Sciences* was jointly organized by the departments of Mathematics, Chemistry, Botany, Nutrition & Dietetics and Computer Sciences.

To create awareness about fake open access journals among researchers, a special meeting was organized by the Research Committee of the college.

To inculcate practical knowledge outside the classroom, industrial trips, institutional visits and educational tour programmes were arranged by all the departments.

To bring out the hidden skills of students, talent shows and a plethora of competitions were conducted by the Fine Arts Club of the college.

The affiliated associations of the College Union and various clubs conducted competitions and the best performers were awarded with certificates and prizes.

**Anti-Ragging Committee** constantly monitors and keeps vigil to curb ragging by implementing preventive measures.

The **Curriculum Development Committee** meetings were held for updating, revising and restructuring the syllabi which could promote innovations across disciplines, entrepreneurial skills and research aptitude among the students seeking exciting career opportunities.

The College Library has been automated by CampesiLIB software with bar coded technology and provides Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC) services. A Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) facility is available for the entire library. The Digital Library provides DELNET and N-LIST under UGC-info net to access E-resources free of cost. The Institutional Repository facilitates the research outputs of faculty and research scholars.

The four **NSS** units of our institution conducted special camp for **7** days in the adopted villages Kattupalayam, Mettur, Saminathapuram and Rajiv Nagar, Modakkurichi. The activities include general medical camp, dental care camp, veterinary camp, white washing, tree plantation and roofing the toilet of Government School, Modakurichi. The NSS units actively participated in the Nationwide Intensive—cleanliness campaign under Swachh Bharat Mission.

NCC cadet L/CPL A.Keethiga got selected up to RD selection Camp -3. Senior under Officer K.Priya Dharshini won Silver Medal in All India Inter Directorate Shooting Championship 2016, at Asansol, West Bengal. Senior under Officer K.Priya Dharshini and Cadet under Officer C.Gowthami took part in 26<sup>th</sup> All India GV Moulonger Shooting Championship held at MRA, Mumbai and won silver medal. L/CPL B.Anushya was selected to attend National Games (khokho) at New Delhi. Cadet Under Officer C.Gowthami was selected for the International Trial at Pune in 60<sup>th</sup> National Shooting Championship Competition, 2016.

Apart from excelling in their academic and co curricular activities, the students proved their mettle by winning Shields and Trophies in intramural and extramural tournaments. The eminent players, M. Sathiyapriya and J. Santhiya from II B.A English with K. Vijayakumari II B.Sc Maths as the team captain, represented Tamilnadu Football Team for the Junior National Football Tournament held at Cuttack, Odisha and won III Place. Nineteen students from the college were selected for All India Inter University level tournaments for Hockey, Hand Ball, Foot Ball, Ball Badminton and Kabadi.

NSS and Youth Red Cross conducted *Blood Donation Camp* on Founder's Day of Vellalar Educational Trust and donated **64** units of blood to Government Hospital, Erode.YRC organized a First Aid training programme.

# **Research Programmes**

Our faculty members produced **8** Ph.Ds and **30** M.Phils during this academic year. Currently one Major Research Project and **12** Minor Research Projects funded by UGC have been carried out by the faculty members.

Three Biannual Research Journals are published by our institution. This year, these Journals have started getting subscriptions from various academic institutions.

# Participation and Presentation of Papers in Seminars / Conferences and Research Publications

To rejuvenate and enrich their knowledge and skills the faculty members attended 65 Faculty Development Programme/ Retraining Programmes, 43 workshops, 29 symposia, 64 seminars and 69 conferences. Our faculty members have served as resource persons in 28 programmes including conferences, orientation/refresher courses, seminars etc. Apart from this, 2 staff members from aided stream attended Orientation Programme and 2 members attended Refresher Course organised by Academic Staff Colleges.

Our staff members participated and presented **118** research papers at State, National and International level Seminars/Conferences to achieve excellence in the field of research. Four faculty members of the college received best paper presentation award in International and National Conferences.

Besides, **182** Research publications in refereed International and National Journals have been brought out by the faculty during this year. The faculty members of Zoology conducted bird survey in the college premises and published a book entitled "**Motley Wings**", which will serve as a field guide on birds in Vellalar Campus. **Dr.R.Nirmala Devi** and **Dr.N.M.Kavitha** of Tamil department and **Dr.S.Kalaiselvi** of Commerce CA department published one book each. **125** video tutorials were created by the staff members using Camtesia Studio.

Dr.R.Parvathi, Head of Department of Mathematics and Dr.S.Sharmila, Assistant Professor of Botany were awarded with Summer Research Fellowship- Science Academies' sponsored by Indian Academy of Science, Bangalore (IAS), National Academy of Sciences India (NASI), Allahabad and Indian National Science Academy (INSA), New Delhi and attended Summer Research Programme at IIT Bombay and CAS in Marine Biology, Annamalai University respectively. **Three** staff members have been selected for Summer Research Fellowship of 2017 by these 3 Science Academies.

# Research Scholars/ Students Outstanding Performance

To acquire more comprehensive knowledge on research, **9** Under Graduate students of Mathematics have participated in MTTS programme, summer training camp under DST Scholarship for Higher Education, Summer and Winter school in Mathematics organized by National Board of Higher Mathematics at IIT Madras, National Institute of Science Education and Research, Bhubaneswar, Central University, Tamil Nadu and Yadava College, Madurai.

To enrich their knowledge in research area, the research scholars and students attended **148** programmes including conferences, seminars, workshops and symposia organised by various institutions. They presented **75** research papers in various disciplines of which **four** were rewarded with *Best Paper Presentation Award*.
